## HOW TO PLAY

**Players:** 2-6 players can play at one time. Each player needs a stone to place at the number 1, the START.

**Materials:** a dice and stones (if you don't have a dice, you can write numbers 1-6 on pieces of paper and put in an opaque bag). **Rules:** The winner is the person who lands on number 100 first. Each player takes in turn to throw the dice (or choose a number from the bag). This number corresponds with the number of places to move their stone.

They should read aloud the text in the box where they land. If they land on a LADDER, they 'climb the ladder', move further up the game. If they land on a SNAKES HEAD, they have to slide down the snake to its tail, going backwards.
